

Application for the 2021 Ramp Less Traveled College Scholarship and Mentoring Program

Description and Details

Ramp Less Traveled is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization dedicated to assisting those with spinal cord injuries in the pursuit of higher education. We understand how dramatically lives change following injury, and how even the most mundane tasks can seem overwhelming in light of a new lifestyle. The idea of going or returning to college can seem distant and unmanageable. Several issues need to be addressed – from housing modification and administrative support to academic accommodations, equal access to social opportunities, and more. *We're here to help*. Ramp Less Traveled is committed to making the dream of attending college a reality by lowering the barriers to entry and easing the difficult transition from hospital floor to college dorm.

We offer a two-part solution:

- A \$2,500 **scholarship** to be used for educational or personal expenses at an American college or university. In some years, depending on funding availability, we are able to offer scholarships of higher value.
- A mentoring relationship that allows scholarship winners to partner with an experienced mentor from Ramp Less Traveled to facilitate a successful college transition. Your mentor will be an advocate throughout the entire process outlining initial steps to take, recommending outside agencies to contact like vocational rehabilitation, and helping you work with college administrators.

We accept applications on a rolling basis, but priority will be given to those received before May 15th, 2021.

Eligibility Requirements

To be considered, applicants must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- Have sustained a spinal cord injury that caused you to take a leave of absence from school.
- Possess a desire to attend college.
- Commit to working with a mentor from Ramp Less Traveled.
